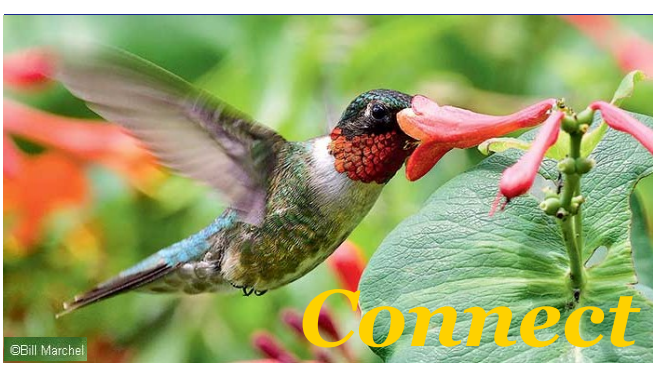

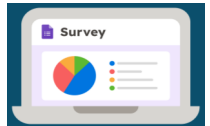
## Walking for Dreams
