
inviting us to trust in the One who knows us, to place our hope in the One who saves us.

*CONFESSION AND PARDON



They said, "Is this not Joseph's son?" He said to them, "Doubtless you will quote to me this proverb, 'Doctor, cure yourself!' And you will say, 'Do here also in your hometown the things that we have heard you did at Capernaum." And he said, "Truly I tell you, no prophet is accepted in his hometown.





The bread will be passed to you first; then the cup will be passed to you.


