Both set in Ireland, Foster is the first-person story of twelve-yearold girl sent to live with foster parents for a season, and in the award-winning Small Things Like These a middle-aged man slowly grasps the enormity of the local convent's heartless treatment of unmarried mothers and their babies.



On July 14, the group will discuss Say Nothing by Patrick Radden Keefe. It is a true story of memory and murder in the time of Northern Ireland's Troubles.
