Justice is not possible in a world of strife. The



wider church, but 25% of what First Pres gives stays right here in Evansville. Special envelopes will be in your worship bulletin this week. Please give generously.




October's book is *The Barn* by Wright Thompson. The barn of the title is the place where 14-year-old Emmett Till was murdered by




